### 10<sup>th</sup> Year Foundation Day Celebration:

The TENTH YEAR foundation day of our was celebrated in a grand manner on 25<sup>th</sup> March 2024 at Hotel Ashoka, Egmore, Chennai. 65 of our Trust members and 10 distinguished dignitaries attended the function. S/Shri. G. Alagarsamy, Pr.CCA(Rtd.) C.Vinod, CGM (Retd), Shri. Ravi PGM(F) (Retd)., and V Vijayamohan, addressed the gathering to commemorate the event. A colourful souvenir was released on the occasion. The Secretary conveyed thanks to S/Shri K Rajaram, S Sethu and Treasurer R Guruprasad for compilation, printing and release of the souvenir. Our members from Vellore, Salem, Erode, Puducherry, Madurai, Karaikudi and Tirunelveli attended the function. A good number of lady members (12) participated. We also invited the family of S/Shri V Sivasamy, S G Jayaprakash and G Vasudevan as a merk of respect to recognize the yeomen services of these founder trustees.

### **Execution of Plus 2 Project:**

Our project coordinators acted very fast and collected the school toppers list from HMS of 177 schools. This year 80% of schools we have selected are from the remote and rural areas of Tamilnadu out of 177 schools, 23 are ADW Schools, 9 are educating differently abled children and 6 are tribal welfare school. Printing of certificates will be taken up next week and certificate will be despatched to the project coordinators in the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of June. Our project coordinators are requested to plan organising award functions from 4<sup>th</sup> week of June, Secretary said. Project coordinators are requested to indicate the date of function to Shri Rajaram and Treasurer in the WhatsApp group to enable them to release amounts and acquittance rolls. All the project coordinators are requested to sign the last page of acquittance roll for having disbursed the amounts to the beneficiaries.

Many of the Trustees wondered whether we can make use of the function to educate the students about important issues including general topics. After discussion, it was decided to include the following topics while visiting schools:

**Environmental awareness**: Students to be properly explained about the importance of using water judiciously without wasting, avoid polluting air, using less paper to save trees, maintain personal hygene etc.

**Avoiding plastic**: Though the Government has already banned usage of plastic bags, yet the same is not scrupulously followed in remote areas. It was decided to include this important awareness in the message to the students.

**Time Management**: Students should be made aware of how best to use time and how to prioritize things in general. How a proper allocation of time for different activities will make them succeed in their life is to be explained.

**Preventing Cellphone Addiction**: The bad effects of cellphone addiction are to be explained to the students to make them aware of the same and underline how best to use the mobile devices for gaining knowledge and at the same time avoid the risk of exposure to radiation etc.

**Caste discrimination**: Adding elaborate examples on how all are to be treated equally and how to ignore caste based approach is an important topic to the sculptors of tomorrow who will build a strong nation. Ill-effects of caste discrimination and its hindrance to social progress is to be explained properly.

**National means cum Merit Scholarship -- NMMS**: A small introduction about the benefits of NMMS, requesting HMS to encourage students studying in 8<sup>th</sup> to appear for the same is to be included. Those who qualify in the exam will get scholarship @ Rs.1000/- per month for the next 4 years. This will help BPL students to continue their studies at least till Plus 2.

**Shri S Ramakrishnan was entrusted with the task** of creating a proper write-up with examples in Tamil and English, to be shared to the project coordinators to use during the function. It was also decided to print a few copies to be distributed during the function as well as requesting the schools to display in their notice board.


Shri M Munusamy proposed vote of thanks and the meeting came to an end.




